Nutritionists:

We employ nine trained nutritionists that are committed to improving your overall bottom line while encouraging teamwork throughout your dairy.

Contracting Feed:

For price protection and/or market advice contact Larry Dvorachek or Tony Newton at (920) 775-9600.

24 Hour Service:

Feed deliveries Monday through Friday. For emergency feed service (weekend or holidays), call the office, follow the instructions, and someone will return your call.

Keep-fill Program:

Office personnel monitor daily feed usage via Bin Sentry or given rates and automatically schedule your next delivery. All Keep-fill accounts receive the 2% early order discount.

Load Size Flexibility:

Bulk deliveries can be made with 20ton quad axle trucks or 24ton semi-trucks.

Bag Route Delivery Service:

Delivery to your farm every two weeks. Our office personnel will contact you two days before your scheduled delivery date. For more detailed information, see page 5 of this packet.

2% Early Order Discount:

Receive a 2% discount with a two-day advanced notice on deliveries Monday through Thursday only. NO Fridays. More information is on page 6 of this packet.

Billing Information:

The billing cycle ends on the 19th of each month and statements are mailed or emailed on the 20th or the next business day after the 20th. They can either be mailed or emailed.

2% Cash Discount:

Given to customers who pay their statement balance in full by the 27th of each month.

Bulk Feed Bins:

New and used feed bins are available to purchase. For more information on our bin program, contact Mike Zutz at (920) 775-9600.

Grain Storage:

Customer grain can be stored at any of the following CP Feeds partners:

-Country Visions: Center Valley, Chilton, Kiel, Mishicot, Readfield, Valders, Whitelaw, Random Lake/Cedar Grove

Normal drying and storage charges apply. There is not an out charge if grains are milled through CP Feeds. If you have soybeans stored at any of the partners, they can be used as roasted beans through CP Feeds.

HACCP is a management system in which food safety is addressed through the analysis and control of biological, chemical, and physical hazards from raw material production, pro-curement and handling, to manufacturing, distribution, and consumption of the finished product. HACCP is being used world-wide to ensure the safety of consumer foods.

History

CP Feeds is a joint venture of Collins Agri-Services and Premier Feeds. Premier Feeds was a consolidation of four Northeast Wisconsin Co-op's feed departments. We began business in July of 2000.

- 2001 ◆ Production started at the Valders feed manufacturing facility

- 2005 ◆ Steady growth required expanding ingredient storage, batching scales, and micro-feeders

- 2007 ◆ A 2nd grinder & an annex were added to increase storage for commodities received by rail
- 2008 ◆ Additional warehouse space was added
- ◆
- 2009 ◆ Equipment upgrades including VFD for feeders were added to increase throughput

- 2011 ◆ The feed division of Agri-Land Co-op and the Malone production facility were added through the merger of one of our co-op partners, and a 10,000 ft² warehouse was added to accommodate our growing SiloStop and bunker cover business
- 2012 ◆ CP Feeds became HACCP Certified
- 2013 ◆ 13,000 square foot warehouse added
- 2014 ◆ Major expansion including bulk ingredient storage, load-out bins and advanced calf feed manufacturing system.

- 2016 ◆ Construction began on new mill in Wrightstown, WI. Feed production slated to begin in the spring of 2018.
- 2017 ◆ The feed division of Kettle Lakes Coop was added through the merger of Country Visions Coop and Kettle Lakes Coop.

- 2018 ◆ Feed production in Wrightstown began.



Route Delivery Program

As an added convenience to our customers, CP Feeds created our bag route delivery program. We have two delivery trucks complete with their own forklift to drop off pallets of product to each farm on the route. The trucks typically run Monday through Thursday and deliver to each farm every two weeks. The delivery route map and schedule can be found at www.cpfeds.com



Orders can be placed during regular business hours, Monday through Friday.

- Two days prior to each scheduled stop, CP Feeds calls you to see if an order is needed.
- Products for route delivery include all custom mixes in bags and all standard bag items.
- Pallets can be placed on the farms, but at a cost to the customer. A rate of \$30/hour will be charged.
- A drop box for invoices should be established between the producer and route driver.
- A route delivery fee of \$35 will be charged for each delivery.
- If a holiday affects the route delivery, all routes maybe reorganized. Please see our route delivery schedule at www.cpfeds.com.

- Boundaries may change, subject to CP Feeds.



Early Order Discount

CP Feeds offers a 2% discount to customers who order in advance. The orders need to be placed two days in advance and deliveries are scheduled for Monday through Thursday only; the discount does not apply to orders delivered on Friday.



SiloStop

As feed prices rise, it is important to use every tool possible to preserve your valuable forages. Along with good harvesting and packing practices, a proven barrier plastic should be part of complete forage storage system.

Bin & Bay Labeling



Since July of 2011 we labeled each bay or bin that we deliver products into. As farms continue to grow, there are more employees placing orders on each farm and more feed storage locations. To avoid any confusion, we have added these labels to aid your employees, our staff, and our truck drivers in the delivery process.

We are instructing your nutritionist to include this number as an integral part of the mix or recipe's name. Examples are as follows:

Low group protein to go in bin 1 = B1 Low Group Protein
High group protein for commodity bay 3 = Y3 High Group
Protein Prefresh to go in bin 4 = B4 Prefresh
